

## Health and Safety Policy

- Report unsafe conditions immediately to supervisor/managers/security.

- Know the location of fire extinguishers, alarms, and their presence at required locations (procedure defined in local language)
- Know the location of the first aid box and procedure to use them (defined in local language)
- Know the safety regulations for their work and area (defined in local language)

## We try to ensure that:

- The environment is safe and free of risks to health at work and in dormitory.
- All workplaces are equipped with adequate safety tools in direct access (refer List of Health & Safety Equipment (Tools).
- Emergency exits are marked for safe and risk less evacuation.
- Adequate information, instruction, training and supervision are provided to all employees, to ensure the health and safety at work and dormitory
- Safe work instructions and procedures are adopted in its true spirit.
- A system for the reporting and investigation of accidents and incidents is followed and corrective action is taken to prevent the re-accurance where possible.
